That on or about the 13th day of September, 2012, at or near Anchorage in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, JASON WALTER BARNUM with intent to cause the death of an APD Officer, engaged in conduct which constituted a substantial step toward the commission of the crime.

Count I

All of which is an unclassified felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.100(a)(1); AS 11.31.100 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count II

That on or about September 13, 2012, at or near Anchorage in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, JASON WALTER BARNUM recklessly placed an APD Officer in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

Count III

That on or about September 13, 2012, at or near Anchorage in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, JASON WALTER BARNUM recklessly placed AN APD Officer in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

The undersigned swears under oath this Information is based upon a review of police report 12-43920 submitted to date.

On September 13, 2012, several Hillside burglaries and vehicle tamperings caused police to eventually go to the vicinity of the Merrill Field Inn to investigate those break-ins. A vehicle associated with the break-ins was located in the parking lot near the Inn. Police then reviewed a surveillance video from the Inn's

surveillance system and saw a man associated with Room 209 taking a tote from the vehicle into Room 209, and later to a dumpster.

Three police officers went to Room 209 to investigate. Three people were in the room at the time – Stephanie Callis, Sam Williams Jr. and Jason Barnum. As it turned out, all three had existing warrants for the their arrest. According to Callis's later interview, all three were aware that the police had arrived.

What happened next is confusing. Barnum and Callis retreated into the bathroom. Once officers got into the room, Williams stalled while police began discussing the reason they were at Room 209. Williams told police that the woman in the bathroom was sick and behind the closed bathroom door, Callis began faking being sick, by making retching sounds. Barnum also confirmed that he told Callis to fake being sick in an effort to dissuade police from entering the bathroom.

Police were not deterred and eventually demanded that Callis come out of the bathroom. As she walked out of the bathroom, Barnum started firing a gun he'd stolen during the Hillside burglaries and vehicle break-ins. Officers returned fire, striking Barnum once in the upper arm. Unfortunately, one of the officers was struck by Barnum.

In his later statements to police Barnum admitted to being a heroin addict who burglarized homes and stole vehicles in order to fund his habit. He was not able to give a long list of the burglaries he'd committed, but police did get confirmation about three strings of recent burglaries in different neighborhoods in Anchorage.

Although the inventory of the stolen property found in Room 209 is far from complete as of today's writing, officers processing the scene in Room 209 indicated that jewelry, jewelry boxes, personal mementos, and other property was found in a backpack within the room.
